- WWSF takes great pleasure in announcing to the media and to the international community the **13 winners** of its annual **Prize for women's creativity in rural life 2008**. The award (\$ 3000 for one selected organization in Africa, and \$ 500 for all other Laureates) honors creative and courageous women and women's groups around the world for their contribution in improving the quality of life in rural communities, for protecting the environment, transmitting knowledge and standing up for human rights and peace. Established in 1994, WWSF has so far awarded 344 prizes in more than 100 countries. The work of

the 13 Laureates 2008 is published on Internet and in our Global Newsletter Edition 16a. We hope that their stories inspire you and encourage others to make their mark in promoting the human rights of women, ending poverty, preserving the planet, and safeguarding our cultural heritage. www.woman.ch/women/1-laureates.php
